Q:	What surfaces does Easy Shield protect?	Q:	What is the coverage of a 250ml Bottle?
A:	Easy Shield can be used on Stainless Steel, Chrome, Polished Brass and Aluminium (without oxidation)	A:	On average around 20m2.
Q:	Easy Shield vs. Polishes.	Q:	Easy Shield vs. Stainless Steel Cleaners.
A:	Easy Shield is designed to protect Stainless Steel and Chrome without the use of harsh abrasives used within polishes. It is also better at getting into and protecting tight areas where buffing with a conventional polish would be impossible.	A:	Easy application would be the first benefit as it's a simple wipe on and wipe off without the hard buffing. You also do not get black hands as it doesn't contain hydro-carbon solvents.
Q:	What is the best way to apply the Easy Shield?		How long does Easy Shield Last?
A:	Depends on the item being coated. We generally use a paint brush for tight areas like stainless turnbuckles. Apply a thin uniform coating, allow the product to cloud then rub over with a clean cloth. For larger flat surfaces a cloth is fine for application. Again apply a thin coating and let it cloud and rub off with a clean cloth. For stainless steel please rub along the grain.		Depends on the environment it is being used in. We recommend re-application after 6-9 months. This time is based on a yacht that had all stainless and chrome treated. It is moored in a salt water environment and fully exposed to the weather. It was reapplied before any signs of deterioration to avoid having to start the cleaning process again.
Q:	How long is the shelf life?	Q:	How long does it take to use?
A:	The product has no shelf life as long as the lid is kept tightly closed.	A:	After application it only takes a minute or two before it can be buffed off with a soft cloth.
Q:	What preparation is required before using the Easy Shield?	Q:	Will the Easy Shield remove oxidation off aluminium?
A:	Make sure the surface is clean, free from other products and dry before application. Do not apply to hot metal.	A:	No, it is not a cleaner.
Q:	Will the Easy Shield affect good metal?	Q:	Will it affect timber, rubber or plastic?
A:	No, it is simply a protective coating.	A:	No, It has no effect on these materials.
Q:	What Safety Gear is Required and is it dangerous to use?	Q:	What sizes are available?
A:	We recommend gloves and safety glasses as a precaution.	A:	250g and 1L Bottles
Q:	Do you have Material Data Safety Sheets?	Q:	Where is the product made?
A:	Yes. They are all available on our website.	A:	We are located in Brendale in Brisbane and the products are manufactured here.
Q:	Is it economical to use?	Q:	Will the Easy Shield remove paint?
A:	Yes very. 20m2 per bottle, minimal application time and 6-9 months of just using a wet cloth with no chemicals for cleaning.	A:	No

Troubleshooting

Easy Shield would not buff off easily.

This is either caused by applying to hot metal or a porous surface that the product is not designed for.
